COUNCIL OF AMERICAN OVERSEAS RESEARCH CENTERS – a federation of independent overseas research centers that promote advanced research, particularly in the humanities and social sciences, with a focus on the conservation and recording of cultural heritage and the understanding and interpretation of modern societies

- NEH Senior Research Fellowship – advanced research in the humanities in an eligible country – 4 months – applications open in September
- Multi-Country Research Fellowship – advanced regional or trans-regional research in the humanities, social sciences, or allied natural sciences – minimum of 90 days – applications open in September

DUMBARTON OAKS RESEARCH LIBRARY AND COLLECTION – an institute in Washington, DC, administered by the Trustees for Harvard University; the legacy of Robert and Mildred Woods Bliss to Harvard University and to the humanities

- Three areas of study: Byzantine studies (including related aspects of late Roman, early Christian, western Medieval, Slavic, and near Eastern studies); pre-Columbian studies (of Mexico, Central America and Andean South America); and garden and landscape studies, including garden history, landscape architecture, and related disciplines

 - Postdoctoral Fellowships – emerging scholars complete work on projects related to the Getty Research Institute’s annual research theme – in residence for nine months (late-September to late-June) – deadline October 2

 - Conservation Guest Scholar Grants – provide senior-level professional with the opportunity to pursue research on topics and issues relevant to conservation – in residence at the Getty Center for 3 or 6 consecutive months – deadline TBA

- Long-term fellowships – 2-12 months – for scholars and researchers in the humanities or social sciences – deadline November 1

- Residential Scholar Program – for scholars who have completed their research (from the perspective of anthropology or from related fields such as history and sociology) and need time to prepare manuscripts – 9 months –

- ASECS/Clark Fellowships – jointly sponsored by the American Society for Eighteenth-Century Studies – projects in the Restoration or the eighteenth century – must be an ASECS member – 1 month – deadline February 1
- Clark-Huntington Joint Bibliographical Fellowship – jointly sponsored by the Huntington Library – bibliographical research in early modern British literature and history and other areas where libraries have common strengths – 2 months – deadline February 1
- Clark Short-Term Fellowships – projects that require work in any area of the Library’s collections (Incunabula, Tudor & Early Stuart, Long 18th Century, Oscar Wilde, Book Arts, Montana and the West) – 1-3 months – deadline February 1
- Kanner Fellowship in British Studies – projects pertaining to British history and culture – 3 months – deadline February 1
